III) Public Comment - none

V) Port annual report progress

- a) Annual report for Board of Trustees (Jan – Dec. 2019) due with a focus on low hanging fruit, prioritizations and recommendations-Jeremy to reach out to Brian Dodd on this

-Trails - Review priority connections/new –

- b) Rose Farm trail connection – reviewed by engineers and it was determined that this needs to be at correct elevation. The whole concrete portion is to be completed into the park by contractors.
- c) The committee also discussed a new project located at Bein Park and 10th
The recommendation would be to run a (7.5 ft. wide) concrete connection along the Outfield fence which would connect to the playground sidewalk, then take the same line As the current fitness trail (6 ft. wide) extension of the sidewalk to Spartan Ave.
It's important to note that this would not be a regional connection and the that crusher refine Material loop in Bein would remain the same (e.g. no additional concrete to the loop)

There was discussion of the Poles that run along the fence and if this would be an issue laying Concrete. There was also discussion to post signs where the trail would become narrow to notify To cyclists to slow down.

- d) Heron Lakes – Begin discussion of loop trail including 8-foot-wide Concrete trail with fence- the project at Heron Lakes has 600k allocated in the budget and was bid out by the Heron Lakes developer. There was also discussion of placing some sandstone in Heron Lakes in the trail area Which would be not only functional but aesthetically pleasing.
- e) TAC Grant – (see attachment) this grant has been approved for \$200k and the town approved \$240k for a total of \$440k for the project of Berthoud Trail Gap Elimination ½ mile connectivity provision (East side of Country Road 17).

-Review Hillsdale trail improvements

- a) A portion of the west side of Hillsdale floods creating the effect of water flowing on all sides to the trail in this section and creating a muddy section which could impose problems to wash out crusher fine trails.

A ditch is proposed to create proper flow to creek drainage.

There is also a discussion to have an addition of a concrete connection on road from last house on

Longview (NW corner of Hillsdale park. The original trail loop will remain as a crusher fine trail.

Staff updates Committee updates

- a) Pioneer Park – Pavilion repair included doors, ceiling, posts, water fountain and replacement of plywood to create a huge improvement to the park
- b) Bein Park a sidewalk was put in on a portion of the south side for more continuity
- c) Berthoud Dog park had an opening on March 28, 2020
An Eagle scout and his troop added concrete tubes and stepping stones

Future ideas for the park include:

- a) Shelter shade feature
- b) Water feature
- c) Continue to keep natural and durable feature
- d) Crusher refine trail by dog park where pedestrians are already creating a trail

Other

- a) Discussion of future meetings on Zoom
June will be on Zoom, future months TBD
- b) Len discussed extending bike safety and education for kids to adults/motor vehicle operators to ensure all involved are refreshed on bike/pedestrian rights, safe vehicle/pedestrian/bike interaction and violations. He is speaking with Deputy Fay on this issue and will keep the committee informed of what he finds out.
